Le Millénaire, a pavilion of the Médéric-Gravel school opened in 2017 and located in La Baie in the Saguenay-Lac-Saint-Jean region, is committed to educating its 169 students about current environmental and technological issues. Horticulture and culinary workshops are at the heart of their learning process. From a very young age, the children get their hands dirty through various gardening and cooking workshops. They learn to live in harmony with their environment.

The programme funded by the Farm to School grant will bring together students, families and the community around a "food village". The next step will be to introduce a free salad bar once or twice a week! All students will have equal access to the salad bar and will be able to tantalize their taste buds with a variety of healthy, local and environmentally responsible foods.

The produce that the children taste comes mainly from their summer garden, but also from their four-season greenhouse and from local producers such as Les jardins Baies Lactées.
